Also, if you are 70 1/2 or older, you may be able to reduce your taxable income this year with a gift made directly from your IRA to our parish.

Talk to your advisor and IRA administrator for more information and to be sure that a gift is made directly from an IRA to a qualified charity such as our parish.

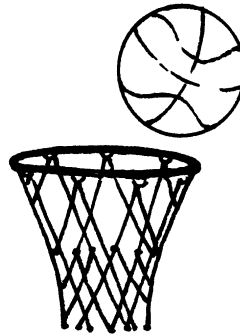

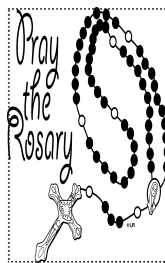

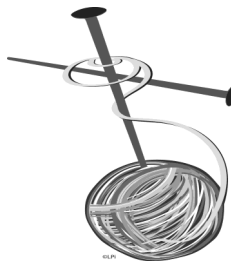
