## Fr. Bob Comments:

Charitable events that will make use of our hall – Ester Ryan dinner to raise funds for children needing shoes was very successful, BACM will have their fund raiser April 3, Embrace will be having a Mass and recognition dinner, Norton Garden Club will have their Spring flower sale, and Right to Life will have a flower sale after Masses on Mother's Day.

Damaged floor in rectory was repaired, Computer panel on the school boilers was replaced, collections for the last six months of 2023 were up 1.2% and Major Repairs was up1.6%. Thank you for supporting the work of our parish and helping avoid emergency appeals when major repairs are needed.

Stock profits have been up. We use these for parish events such as the picnic (\$10,736), Octoberfest and Christmas Breakfast (\$3462). As of Dec. 31, \$48K remained in the profit account.

All parishes will be working on Supporting Catholic Elementary schools pastorally and/or financially. The Diocese has assigned us to a group that includes St. Andrew, Sacred Heart, Ss. Peter & Paul and St. Anne. The pastors and a parish representative will serve on the committee. Paula Trenta has agreed to be our representative.
